Breakfast Club

We do not cap our numbers, however, both start times MUST be prebooked to ensure we have enough staff to support the children and enough food available to feed them.

7.45am start costs £1.50 per day. Book and pay in advance at the office.

8.15am start is free. Book at the office by Thursday for the following week.

Even if your child has attended during one week you MUST RE-BOOK for the following week.

Children who are not booked in or arrive late may not attend.
