

## See Saw Home Learning How-To Guide

During The time that the school is shut, we want to ensure your child is able to continue their learning At the Alton, we have set up a number of ways that your child can continue this learning at home.

### SeeSaw for Early Years, Resource Base and Key Stage 1

Your child has a username and password for SeeSaw, where their teacher will post work for them to complete. Their weekly homework will be posted on SeeSaw, but also their Home Learning while they are self-isolating.

Here is how to use it:

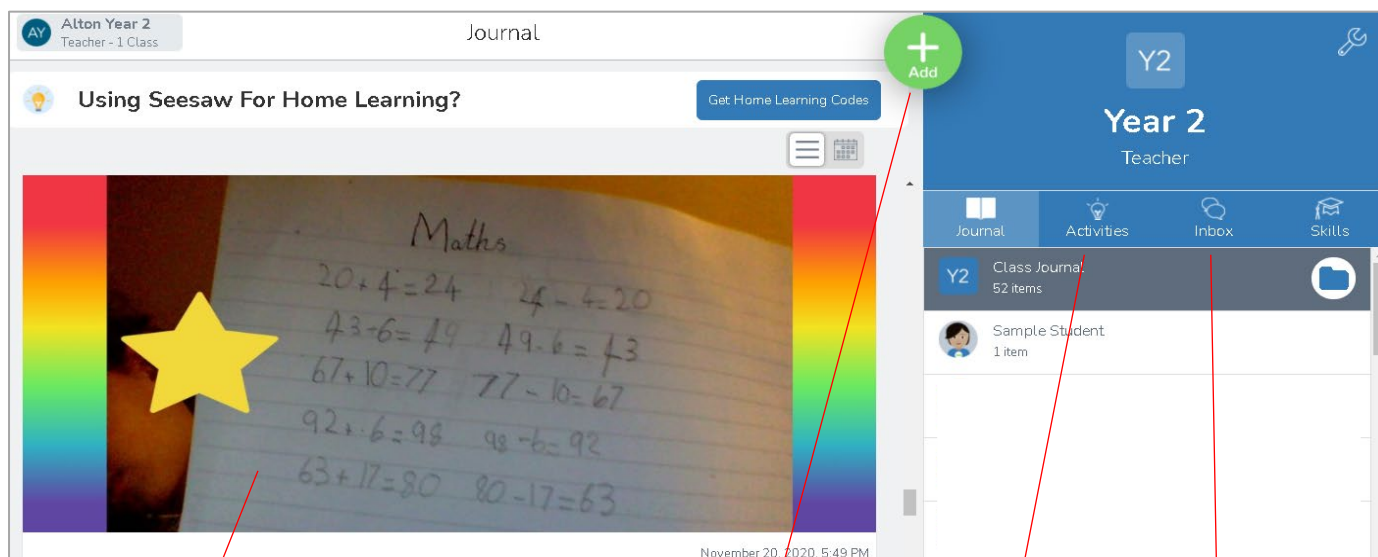
- 1.) Go to [web.seesaw.me](http://web.seesaw.me)
- 2.) Choose
- 3.) I am a Student
- 4.) Choose Sign In with Google (This is the top option)

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6.) The page will look like this:

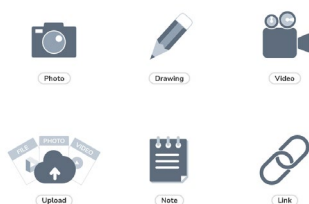


This is the Journal. Here you will see all of your child's work that has been posted, and any work the teacher has shared with the whole class.

Underneath each piece of work, the teacher can comment, like or make an audio recording to give feedback about your work.

Click on the "Add" button to upload the work you have done!

Choose how you would like to upload it:



This is the Inbox. This is where you will find any messages or notifications from the teacher.

"Activities" is the tab where your teacher will assign work each week.

Note that "Homework" is for all children to complete once weekly. "Home Learning" is for children who are self-isolating.

### Maths

For children in Years 1 -6, the maths work that your child will be assigned will be from the Maths No Problem website. Your child's class teacher will have put this information for you on SeeSaw:

Please sign up to the Maths No Problem Parent Guide online, this will give you access to the textbook and workbook that we are using in class. I will upload a document to make it clear which lesson I will be teaching in class each day - please can you complete the same lesson, so that when you return to school you are up to date with the learning. Sign up for Parent Guides by following this link and entering this access code. Link: <https://hub.mathsnoproblem.com/self-signup/C7A003I> The Access Code will be given to you by your teacher.

If you sign up for the Maths No Problem Parent guides via the link shown, you should be directed to all of the lessons from the Maths No Problem textbooks that are used at school. Your child's class teacher should inform you on SeeSaw which lessons to use.
