Secondary School Transfer Event


We are holding our secondary school transfer event on **Thursday 25 June 2026 from 3.20pm - 4.30pm**. This meeting is **open to all parents and carers of children in Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5**. It will take place in the school hall at The Alton straight after pick-up time and will last for around one hour.

There will be a presentation explaining how to apply for your child's secondary school place, followed by the opportunity for you to meet people from local state secondary schools, ask them questions and pick up information.
