Flu Immunisations

Flu immunisations were given in school on Monday. If your child did not have permission to receive it, please consider attending a catch-up clinic, details below.

Children can catch and spread flu easily. Each winter in the UK, thousands of children who do not have a health condition need hospital care because of flu. The flu vaccine helps protect children from illness and serious complications, such as pneumonia. Vaccinating children also helps to protect family members and others around them such as anyone who is pregnant, babies and older people.

The vaccine is delivered by nasal spray, which is quick, painless and serious side effects are uncommon. If your child can't have the spray, an injectable gelatine-free vaccine is available instead. Further information about the flu jab is available on the NHS website.
